Scholarship Application - March 2024

The Development Association of Rock Island (DARI) is offering a scholarship to a Rock Island high school senior as a part of our community marketing campaign - *Why Rock Island*. Participants are asked to use their imagination to create a video or other visual that tells the story *Why Rock Island* is a great place to live, work and play. DARI will use the stories to help market Rock Island.

DARI SCHOLARSHIP RULES:

Applicant must be attending a Rock Island high school and reside in Rock Island, Illinois.

The DARI Scholarship Application Form must be completed for consideration. All answers must be typed.

A Visual essay is required that describes **Why Rock Island** is a wonderful place to live, work and play. You will need to create a video (5 minutes or less) or a Photo visual. A link to your visual documentation must be included in your application (for example a link to a YouTube video, Google Doc, TikTok, PowerPoint, etc.)

The completed application form and required documentation are to be **submitted via email by May 15, 2024.** Application Documentation will include the following:

- Completed typed Application Form.
- Written Essay.
- Visual Essay A link to your visual documentation.
- Letter of Reference (which will be emailed separately to DARI).
- Permission for the Release of Video/Visual Materials.

A panel representing the Development Association of Rock Island Executive Board of Directors will review the scholarship applications and select the final winners.

There will be one winner selected for a \$5,000 scholarship for the 2024-2025 academic year. Awards are for one year and will be paid directly to the college/university of enrollment upon receipt of verification of enrollment. The DARI board reserves the right to modify or alter the amount of awards.

Scholarship winners will be asked to submit a photo of themselves to be featured in a media release, social media and other promotional materials.

Winners will be announced in June 2024.
